Ordinance No. 40.1

The City Council of the City of Finlayson ordains to pass an **amendment to Ordinance No. 40.1**.
Ordinance shall be amended to read as follows:

No open burning will be allowed in the Finlayson City Proper with the exception of barbecue grills, permanently installed barbecue pits and small recreational fires.

Recreational fires:

- Only unfinished wood, not less than one inch in diameter may be used.
- The fire must be three feet in diameter or smaller.
- The fire must be located no closer than 25 feet from a structure or any combustible storage.
- Burning of paper, refuse, or flammable/combustible liquids is prohibited.
- Buckets, shovels, or garden hoses shall be readily available to extinguish the fire.
- Recreational fires shall be constantly attended by an adult knowledgeable in the use of the fire extinguishing equipment available. Constant attendance is required until the fire is extinguished.
- Conditions which could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure or combustible storage must be eliminated prior to ignition.
- The fire chief or the chief's designee is authorized to require that recreational fires be immediately discontinued if such fires are determined by that individual to constitute a hazardous condition.

Violations of this ordinance will be in accordance with ordinance #40. Each violation: \$250.00 fine.
The fire may be fully extinguished by member(s) of the local fire department.
