

ORDINANCE NO 8

An ordinance to restrain the running at large of swine, horses, mules, oxen, stallions or bulls and to authorize the detaining the same, and to impose penalties upon the owner for the violation of this ordinance. The common council of the Village of Finlayson do ordain:

Section 1: From and after the passage of this ordinance, it shall not be lawful for any swine, horse, etc, to run at large within the corporate limits of the Village of Finlayson

Section 2: If any swine, etc, shall be running at large within the limits of said village, it shall be the duty of the marshal of said village to take and impound such swine, etc and if the owner or claimer of such shall not within twenty four hours thereafter pay to the marshal the sum of fifty cents per head for such animals so impounded, and the fees and cost of said marshal for his services, it shall be the duty of the marshal to sell such animal as provided by law in such case, the sale to be at public auction to the highest bidder.

Section 3: The marshal shall pay over to the village treasurer the sum of fifty cents for each such animal so impounded and sold, or in case the costs are paid by the owner or claimer before the sale, the said sum shall be retained for the village and he may retain the fees and cost allowed to him and in case of the sale of any said animals so impounded, the marshal after deducting all costs and expenses of impounding and selling the same shall deposit the surplus, if any with the village treasurer for the benefit of the owner or claimant of such animal.

Section 4: The marshal shall be entitled to and may receive for his services the sum of fifty cents for every such animal so taken up and impounded and the sum of twenty five cents for each notice of sale posted as his fees.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after is passage.
